Allows for a transition so that tenants can learn life skills. They have programs in Moscow/Pullman. • Jackie Sayer, Idaho Housing. Reported over 700 in the Region. Has a program for veterans called VASH and has 12 vouchers for the region. Shelter plus care program which is on a grant with no time limit. There is a program called “homeless prevention”. For an emergency type of situation. This would be for a 1-time payment of \$500 or less. Only contact that can be made is on Tuesdays. • Frank Wright – Is participating to get a homeless shelter program for Veterans. • Dean Allen – private practitioner in counseling. • Chris St. Germaine – developed a Workplace Readiness program for the CWC PSC programs. Chris reported of being a part of an “Opportunity Fund” program for rural areas. Big banking funds would be involved to provide a certain percentage. • Dorothy Pollman – CWC MHC and DC – Dorothy currently has 7 people in her programs that are struggling with housing needs. • Motion for minutes to be approved – Chris ; 2nd Dorothy • Steve reported that there is a Homeless Task Force in Clarkston that meets once a month and is scheduled for 12/18 at 10:30am at the Board meeting room at the Clarkston School District. • Chris asked if there was a way to develop an inventory of housing need for each county.
