Hoping to develop incentive to get more LE trained via ICRMP. Spoke with Chad Sarmiento at ICRMP who does CIT training in one day for POST credits. Mike asked Chad if he'd be willing to speak to the subcommittee vs board about his CIT training. Shari will discuss at board meeting today to decide whether to bring Chad to board or only this s/c.</p> <p>Warming center: Teresa didn't find out, checked with staff in real-time during meeting. Staff are not aware of anything at this time in the valley, but there is a nighttime warming shelter in Lapwai: 208-790-0857. People are able to stay overnight from 11pm to 7am.</p> <p>CIT: R2 will plan online CIT training. We need to make it POST certified. Laura said it will take about a month for POST to review to approve.</p> <p>18-212: Update on commitments workgroup for IBHC. Finalizing subworkgroup deliverables, then will present to IBHC. Same situation for civil commit workgroup</p> <p>CFH: reimbursement is cited as barrier to recruitment. Will need to find other paths, likely. IBHC is getting recs to fund other options.</p> <p>Jenny reports Riverside Recovery has a program for RCs to go into the jail to provide supports for after release. Jenny and Teresa will talk offline. References sequential intercept model.</p>

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Des/18-212 evals – no shortage any longer due to remote evaluations and availability across state.
